I had the opportunity to preach during the main service while Brenna shared her testimony during Sunday School. From there, we traveled to Owasso for the World Missions Conference at **Friendship Baptist Church**. Pastor Linzy Slayden and the entire team at FBC went above and beyond to make our time there unforgettable. From helping with vehicle needs to arranging chiropractic care and blessing us with their generosity, they demonstrated Christ's love in action. We are so grateful for their partnership in the gospel. While at FBC, we were also blessed with a wonderful host family who cared for us so kindly during our stay, and we are honored to now count them as dear friends.

This divine pattern repeats throughout Scripture and history: **God uses people like us to proclaim His message.** What a sobering and glorious calling. Let us never forget the privilege and responsibility we have to obey the Great Commission.

May God already be preparing the "Corneliuses" of Nepal—those whom He is drawing to Himself—and may we be faithful to walk through the doors He opens to share Christ with them.

A That we would be an encouragement to every church we visit, inspiring


congregants to be actively involved in God's mission, whether through prayer, giving, or going.





